

THE GAME

A Blackjack game where only one hit card is allowed. Players can also play for a poker hand. Players decide to either stand on the two-card hand or take one hit card. But be careful, all bets are at risk when taking a hit. If you go over 21, all bets (Blackjack and Poker Play) are taken. Dealer hits 15 or less.

HOW TO PLAY

Place a Blackjack bet and the optional Poker Play bet at the start of the game. The dealer deals the cards as in regular Blackjack: two cards face up to each player; one card face up and one card face down for the dealer. Players decide to hit or stand.

When placing the optional Poker Play bet, the initial 2 cards, or 3 cards if a hit is taken, are playing for the Poker Play pay table. Players may ONLY split Aces and may NOT re-split. Players cannot place an additional Poker Play bet on the split hand; only the Poker Play bet on the original hand will be in play.

Doubling down is NOT allowed.

The dealer takes one hit card with 15 or less and stands with 16 and higher.





3-CARD Blackjack

How to Win

- Players can win two (2) ways:
 - The player's Blackjack hand beats the dealer's Blackjack hand and wins even money.
 - 2. The player's Blackjack hand qualifies for the Poker Play pay table and wins the odds.
- Players may not exceed 21 to win from the Poker Play pay table.
- Blackjack pays even money.

3-of-a-Kind Flush	100 to 1
Straight Flush	50 to 1
3-of-a-Kind	25 to 1
Straight	10 to 1
Flush	6 to 1
Any Pair	2 to 1
